

DECISION

OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA

No 1383-N of 29 December 2016

ON MAKING AMENDMENTS TO DECISION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF ARMENIA NO 165-N OF 19 FEBRUARY 2015

The Government of the Republic of Armenia hereby *decides*:

1. (1) to have Annex No 1 to Decision of the Government of the Republic of Armenia No 165-N of 19 February 2015 "On creating Anti-Corruption Council and Expert Task Force, on approving the composition of the Council, the Rules of Procedure for Activities of the Council, Expert Task Force and Anti-Corruption Programmes Monitoring Division of the Staff of the Government of the Republic of Armenia" restated pursuant to the Annex;
- (2) to amend point 7 of Annex No 2 to Decision of the Government of the Republic of Armenia No 165-N of 19 February 2015 "On creating Anti-Corruption Council and Expert Task Force, on approving the composition of the Council, the Rules of Procedure for Activities of the Council, Expert Task Force and Anti-Corruption Programmes Monitoring Division of the Staff of the Government of the Republic of Armenia"

as follows:

- "7. The Council may comprise those non-governmental organisations which:
- (1) have had, in the course of the preceding five years, at least three years of work experience in the anti-corruption field;
 - (2) have their involvement in anti-corruption activities provided for by

their Charter;

(3) have experience in co-operating with international organisations in the anti-corruption field;

(4) will submit information on at least two programmes implemented with international institutions and/or on their own initiative in the anti-corruption field;

(5) will submit a positive opinion (assessment) issued by a partner organisation on the effectiveness of the programmes implemented with international institutions."

2. This Decision shall enter into force on the tenth day following official promulgation.
